Here is a list of things you may need to consider before writing your will. If you come to part of the process that you are unsure about you can always save it and come back to it later.

- Children
 - o Full names
 - Year of birth
 - Guardianship If you have children under 18 you can appoint and guardian or guardians who will care for your children in the event of death
- Executorship
 - Who is going to ensure that your will's instructions are carried out?
 - o You can appoint more than on executor
- Funeral wishes
 - Use of your body for research and transplants
 - o Funeral directions:
 - Burial or cremation?
 - Specific place?
 - Scattering of ashes
 - Other wishes (readings, songs etc.)
 - o In Memoriam Gifts
 - Gifts to charities from family members/others
- Distribution of estate
 - O Who do you want to leave what?
 - Specified items?
 - o Residue?
 - o Charity?
